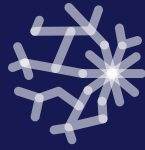

**Survivors face lifelong  
consequences, Korrin Barrett  
shares her story.**

**Korrin Barrett** was a vivacious, fit and healthy 33-year-old, but in 2012 Korrin was rushed into hospital. After mismanagement of a medical condition she was admitted to intensive care with sepsis and was given a 5% chance of survival! Nine days later, when Korrin miraculously awoke from the coma, she received the devastating news that to save her life, both her legs and hands would have to be amputated.

Korrin will share her inspirational story with Dr Paul Huggan. Paul will highlight for both clinicians and the public signs to watch for. Just ask, could this be sepsis?
